The program seeks to support school leadership teams to develop a deeper understanding of the educational evidence base of school improvement, the science of learning and the science of reading, and how to apply this knowledge to transform their school to positively impact student outcomes.

## **Overall program objectives**

Participants will:

- gain a broad perspective of the Australian education context, including the related challenges and complexities of leading school improvement to achieve meaningful student outcomes
- identify high impact evidence-based levers and a hierarchical process to determining the 'right' work to improve student outcomes
- understand the key concepts from research that support the science of learning and Science of Reading, and the implications these have for leading effective teaching and learning in schools
- design an action plan for school improvement, utilising an evidence-based approach, with schoolbased data as a foundation.

As part of the preparation for the program there are some pre-readings and pre-work to complete, which will assist participants to gain the most out of the workshop activities.
